COVID-19 DETACHED YOUTH WORK RISK ASSESSMENT

Description of Task: Re-starting Detached youth work as lockdown eases

People at Risk: Detached Coordinator, Volunteers, Young people

Benefits of Activity: Re-connecting with young people and connecting with new ones who are getting back out on the streets and in the park. Rebuilding and building relationships. Talking about there experiences in lockdown, encourage them to act safely as they start to mix.

<p>Volunteers or General Public contracting virus from one another</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Through coughing/sneezing • Through virus being present on hands/surfaces 	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reduce number of volunteers from three to two per session • No volunteers who are shielding or over 70 to be present • Volunteers to socially distance from one another at all time (ideally 2m at all times but 1m+ where this isn't possible) • Any volunteers with Covid-19 symptoms (as defined by the UK government) to stay away or be sent home if they arrive or develop symptoms. • Do not approach larger groups of young people in line with current guidance to avoid gathering in groups larger than 6. • Maintain social distancing with young people (2m) • Do not take equipment etc out on detached to avoid touching shared surfaces. Any snacks to be shared should be pre-packaged. • Hand gel to be take on detached so hands can be cleaned if any surfaces are touched. Volunteers to use gel at start and end of session, or thoroughly washing hands when returning home. 	Low

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| | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Avoid first aid if possible – advise YP to return home or phone for assistance. If unavoidable to apply first aid, use gloves and both parties to wear a facemask. | |
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Actions and Further Considerations

If volunteers feel uncomfortable at any time the session should be kept short and volunteers to return home.

The detached coordinator will continue to monitor the local and national guidance regarding Covid19 and detached will be paused if the guidance changes or the risk to volunteers or young people changes.
